I thank you for your kind and interesting letter of the 6th May 1969. There are however one or two things I would bring to your notice before dealing with your main question.. Sun's disappearance and darkness resulting thought to be due to earth's spherical shape.

Continuation of letter of July 5th 1969. Dealing with question.

Now, with the hope that I may present a fair answer to your question re: the Sun and your Bangkok to Rome Flight. There are points NOT stated. 1. Such as time of year- season. 2. Your companion sun. Time & whereabouts it left you. 3. Seasonal knowlege would help re: sun to your right or left. 4. Your assumption sun hidden according to orthodox theory. 5. Some knowledge of Flight route would help.

Somewhat hindered by lack of these points, I reply:-

The Sun is not far distant. It has diurnal motion. A spiral course winding inwards from the equator 15 miles per day Northwards to tropic of Cancer; giving European summertime and on your right hand of flight. Or spiralling outward to Capricorn for Australian, S/African etc: summer in which case sun would be to your lefthand.

The sun's dark body radiates; and through our lower dense atmosphere gives the sense of light and heat. Such effect does not reach us over void, space, & vacuum of 93 millions of miles but being near to earth it's light or radiation is is very limited. If you study the subject you will see that sun's light retracts with & follows the sun which is moving over a stationary earth. In this "space" age one of the great evidences of deception is supposed photographic presentat-tion of globularity. Earth is shown (of course) right way up and lit from extreme north to south. This we hold is not true because of the known periods of darkness N & S. Please bare in mind that so-called space is in utter darkness. When I was lecturing, I received close attention when showing that the Total Solar Eclipse of June 30, 1954 was impossible on a whirling globe. Daily worship

THE attention of the ministers of the Christian churches in Dover was drawn at a recent meeting to the request of the Minister of Education (Mr. Edward Short) for "the articulate support of parents throughout Britain to withstand the tremendous pressure for the abolition" of compulsory religious instruction and the daily act of worship in State schools.

On 10th January, 1969, when he made this request, Mr. Short said: "This is the point at which all who care about the preservation of the Christian character of our country must man the barricades."

We have decided to collect signatures in support of the Government's efforts to retain the Christian character of our schools. Church-goers will be informed in their own churches and will be able to sign a statement in support of the Minister of Education. We are aware, however, that many people in Dover who do not go regularly to church will wish to identify themselves with this support.

May I invite them, through the courtesy of your columns, to call on their nearest clergyman, or, if they prefer, to call here, to sign the statement of support.

In an effort to avoid a dreary correspondence in your columns, may I make three further points:

We recognise the right of any parent to withdraw his child either from religious instruction and/or from the daily act of worship.

We recognise that often there is need to improve the manner in which religious instruction is imparted and in which the daily act of worship is carried out.

We recognise that religious instruction must be presented in such a way that a child feels free to accept, discuss or reject it. We would deplore any attempt at brain-washing.

I regret that your interview terminated suddenly. I certainly paid the penalty of stress afterwards.
