

CH9	KJV	These are the Confidential Counsels - Ele Ha-Sodot - Hebrew Revelation
1	And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.	Then the fifth <b>messenger</b> blew, and I saw <i>that</i> a star fell onto <sup>8</sup> the earth from the heavens, and to him the key of <i>the Deep</i> <sup>9</sup> was given.
2	And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.	Then he opened the <b>Deep</b> , and there went out smoke from <i>the Deep</i> , like the smoke of a great oven, and the sun and the air were darkened by the smoke of the <b>Deep</b> . <sup>10</sup>
3	And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, <b>as the scorpions of the earth have power</b> .	And from the smoke there came locusts over the earth, and authority was given to them to destroy.
4	And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads. 12	One woe is past; and, behold, there come two woes more hereafter.	One <sup>8</sup> <b>pain</b> has passed away, look, two more <b>pains</b> are coming!
13	And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,	Then the sixth <b>messenger</b> blew, and I heard a voice from the four <b>corners</b> of the <b>temple</b> before <b>YHWH</b> ,
14	Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.	and it said to the sixth <b>messenger</b> who blew, “Go and loosen <sup>1</sup> the four <b>messengers</b> who are bound at the <b>great river</b> <sup>2</sup> which is called <b>Perat</b> .” <sup>3</sup>

20	And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:	<b>But there were still many sons of man</b> who did not die by these plagues – because they <b>did</b> <sup>8</sup> repentance from their <b>evil deeds</b> , by not praying to <b>Ha-Satan</b> , neither to the idols which are made of pottery and of stone or wood and silver and gold, which do not have the ability in them to walk or to speak or to hear –
21	Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.	but who did not do repentance concerning their sorceries or concerning their fornication or concerning their thefts.
