

CH16	KJV	These are the Confidential Counsels - Ele Ha-Sodot - Hebrew Revelation
1	And I heard a <b>great</b> voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth.	Then I heard a voice from the <b>house of prayer</b> , and it <sup>1</sup> said to the seven <b>messengers</b> , “Go and pour out the <b>bowls</b> on the earth – the <b>fury of YHWH</b> .”
2	And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image.	So the first went and poured out his <b>bowl</b> on the earth, and it became <b>boils, breaking out</b> on the men who had the <b>sign of the animal</b> and <b>prayed<sup>2</sup></b> to his <b>carved image</b> . <sup>3</sup>
3	And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea.	Then the second <b>messenger</b> poured out his <b>bowl</b> on the sea, and it was <sup>4</sup> blood <b>like that</b> of a dead one, and all that was in the sea died.
4	And the third angel poured out his vial <b>upon the rivers</b> and fountains of waters; and they became blood.	Then the third poured out his <b>bowl</b> on the fountains of waters and it was <sup>5</sup> blood.
5	And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus.	Then I heard that the <b>messenger</b> said, “ <b>YHWH</b> the Righteous, who was and is and [ <i>will be</i> ] <sup>6</sup> – <b>you are qadosh that you gave</b> this judgment,
6	For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.	for they have shed the blood of the <b>set-apart ones</b> and the prophets <b>like waters</b> , and you gave them blood to drink, for they are worthy of <sup>1</sup> <b>this!</b> ”

8	And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire.	Then the fourth poured out his <b>bowl</b> on the sun, and <b>it was given to it, to make heat for man</b> .
9	And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.	Then men had <b>much heat</b> , and they <b>cursed YHWH because of</b> these plagues, but they did not do repentance to give him glory.
10	And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,	Then the fifth poured out his bowl on the <b>throne</b> of the <b>animal</b> , and <b>it was darkened</b> , <sup>3</sup> and they <b>bit</b> their tongues <b>because of the</b> pain. <sup>4</sup>
11	<b>And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.</b>	
12	And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.	Then the sixth poured out his <b>bowl</b> on the river <b>Perat</b> , <sup>5</sup> and the river dried up, <sup>6</sup> to be <sup>7</sup> a path for the kings <b>who are at<sup>8</sup> the rising of the sun</b> . <sup>9</sup>
13	And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.	And I saw that there came forth from the mouth of the dragon and from the mouth of the <b>animal</b> and from the mouth of the false prophet, three unclean <b>creeping things</b> like frogs.
14	For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.	And these are the spirits of <b>Ha-Satan</b> , doing <b>signs and wonders</b> , and they go to <i>the</i> kings of the earth and to all the world, to gather them to war for the day of <b>YHWH the Mighty</b> . <sup>1</sup>
15	Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.	(“Look! I will come like a thief, and blessed are those <b>who do not sleep</b> , but <b>keeps himself</b> that he does not walk naked without clothes, <b>that his nakedness be not uncovered</b> .”)
16	And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.	And he gathered them to a place which is called in the Hebrew tongue, <b>Har-Megidon</b> . <sup>2</sup>
17	And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.	Then the seventh poured out his <b>bowl</b> in the air, and there came a voice from the <b>throne</b> , and said, “This is <b>over!</b> ”
18	And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a <b>great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.</b>	And there were voices and thunders and lightnings, and an earthquake which had never happened before –
19	And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.	and of the great city was made three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And the great city Bavel <sup>3</sup> was remembered before <b>YHWH</b> , to give her the cup with the wine of his <b>burning anger</b> .
20	And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.	And all the mountains and <b>hills</b> fled, and were seen no more.
21	And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, <b>every stone about the weight of a talent</b> : and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; <b>for the plague thereof was exceeding great.</b>	And great hail fell on man from the heavens, and they blasphemed <b>YHWH</b> because of the plague of the hail.
