



Water Consciousness

Well, it started out precisely as the title declares, stating that we are being gestated in a womb and awaiting our second birth above the firmament, but then ended up being totally hijacked by the preexistence discussion, LOL. Good times. It's all connected, especially as far as the

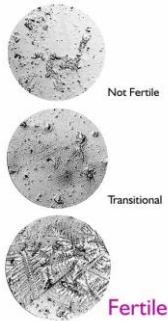

At any rate, the earth is a divine ruach just as assuredly as the sun, moon, and stars are divine ruachoth, the firmament is one too, not forgetting the caretakers of the earth in the weather department, they're all ruachoth, each of which are capable of being obedient or disobedient towards the Most-High. And of course, there is our present discourse regarding sentient water.

The incredible reality is that water is a databank of stored information. And as I hope to show, it communicates with us, though we are mostly ignorant of that fact. I'll take it one step further. In one such experiment, Veda placed a petri dish of water over the picture of a ballerina, **30 seconds** in total, and then removed the image before freezing the water. The ice portrait has the ballerinas head in front of both arms whereas the picture captures it between the two. There are other differences, like in the angle of her legs. 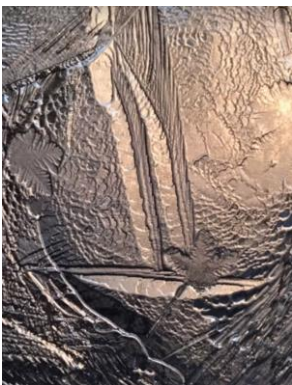

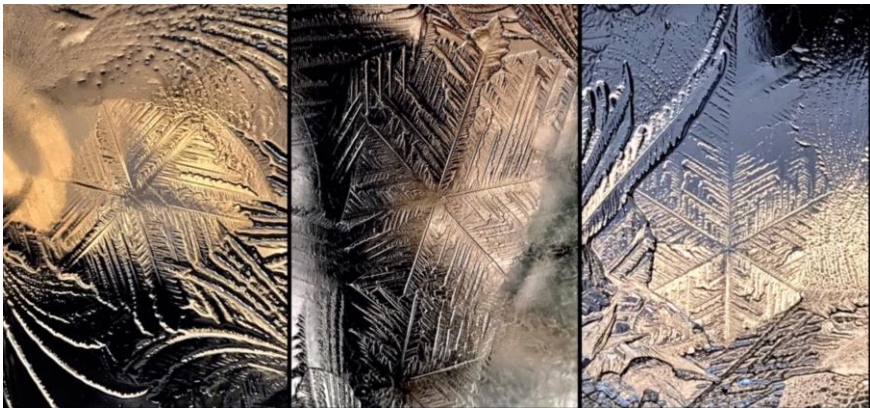

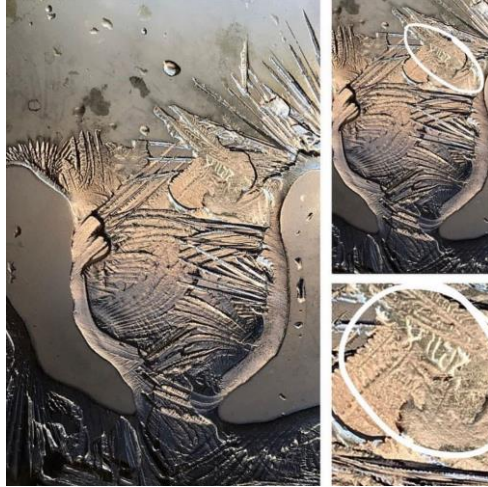
