The Tesla Trump Connection

On January 9, 1943, two days after Nikola Tesla died in a NYC hotel, the FBI called John G. Trump to determine if the belongings of Tesla's estate were deemed dangerous. 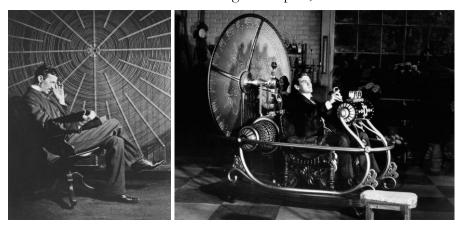
They include but are not limited to wireless lighting (*aka* the Tesla coil), x-rays, radio remote control, mechanical oscillators and generators, and electrical discharge tubes. After working for Edison in his New York Laboratory, Tesla joined Westinghouse at The 1893 Chicago World Fair, which was probably a hoax. Not that Tesla necessarily knew anything about that, though he probably did. It only takes a little research into the Mud Flood and Millennial Kingdom Tech to realize that he was reintroducing, or in the very least rediscovering what had only been lost a century or two earlier. I mean, look at his other pursuits.





Tesla was working towards something which we like to call free energy, and that right there, college grads, is a naughty no-no. Edison would not be pleased. Built in 1901 on Long Island, NY, and then sold for scraps in 1917, Wardenclyffe Tower was intended as a wireless transmission station for sending messages, telephony, and even facsimile images across the Atlantic Ocean to England and to ships at sea based up his theories

of using the Earth as a conduit. Tesla fan boys will argue this point until the astro-nots return home from the NASA pool, but Nikola was totally a component of the flat earth theory. What you don't like that? Well then, come at me, bro, and admit it already. *Listen*. If you open up your mind you can hear it whispered in the soft breeze, *the earth is flat*. Why am I not surprised to learn that the Tower's primary funder, JP Morgan, lost interest in the Antiquitech Tower, and that Tesla was incapable of finding anybody else to invest? I mean, why give humanity free energy when in fact enslavement was far more lucrative an investment—*dur*. Get with it, Tesla. That Tartarian tech was a thing of the past, bro.



By 1895, Tesla had become obsessed with the theory of time travel, a devotion having much to do with his experimentation in magnetic fields. *Dang*, he went from inventing to Tesla Coil to the Flux Capacitor in as little as four years, what have you accomplished? Is it a coincidence that H.G. Wells published The Time Machine that same year? Probably not. I *checked*. Wells was a Lodge Brother, and the Freemasons are all gay so far as I'm concerned. He was 33 as well, double digits. So gay. It is also probably not a coincidence that Nikola Tesla's New York lab burnt down the very month that Wells published his time travel book. Apparently, here is how it happened.

In 1895, a New York Herald reporter is said to have come across Tesla in a small café, looking visibly shaken. When questioned, Tesla told the reporter that he had an "out of time" near death experience by which he could see into the future and the past, though he was nearly electrocuted by 3 million volts in the process. Cool story. The only problem is that I have never been able to verify it. Aside from a thousand claims that it was

so on the Internet. Who is this New York Herald writer and where did he print his report? There are only three elements related to this story that remain certain. New York Herald writers did publish stories on him. Tesla was badly electrocuted in 1895, and more pointedly, the South Fifth Avenue building that housed Tesla's laboratory managed to catch fire on 3/13/1895. Though it reportedly started in the basement, the fire was so intense that Tesla's 4th floor lab collapsed into the second floor.

But then consider the fact that Tesla liked experimenting upon himself. Do me a favor and turn back a few pages. I have already shown you documented evidence of Nikola inserting himself into an electrical-magnetic field and was wondering if you noticed. That's how the time travel incident happened, apparently. While sitting in his chair with his little notebook, legs crossed, he found himself in an entirely different time and space window, capable of seeing the past, present, and future at the same moment. Helen of Troy may have launched a thousand ships, but Tesla is often associated with the missing ship and her crew, via the **Philadelphia Experiment**.





His meeting with King Peter II of Yugoslavia landed on **7/15/1942**. Not that the meeting is important to this narrative. There simply aren't many pictures of Tesla's nephew, Sava Kosanović, and that his him, holding Tesla's arm, third from stage left. Tesla as a senior citizen, tell me that isn't the face of a man who's experienced time travel. Has he discovered the Mystery of Woman, though? The photo on the right belongs to John G. Trump, but we're not there yet.

On 1/8/1943, the morning after Tesla's death, Sava Kosanović arrived at his uncle's apartment only to find it ransacked. Paperwork was missing, including a black notebook that was several hundred pages long. Kosanovic was personally familiar with it and distinctly recalled that some

of its pages were marked **GOVERNMENT**, as if that's not suspect. Perhaps it wasn't the best idea for Tesla to go around claiming he had perfected his 'death ray.' Is this where the **Direct Energy** Weapons responsible for the **Paradise** and **Malibu** fires originated from?

The Gubbernment didn't want Tesla's tech to fall into the wrong hands, LOL, and Kosanović wanted to rub off to Yugoslavia, which is why, on the following day, 1/9/43, the U.S. Office of Alien Property Custodian seized all of Tesla's remaining work. We're talking 2 truckloads of paperwork and artifacts in addition to almost 30 barrels and bundles that had been nabbed from storage. Tesla was a US Citizen. I just thought you should know that. Especially since the 'A' in OAPC is for aliens, and they only dealt with non-US Citizens who were deemed a threat. That would be like receiving a house call from ICE rather than the FBI, but whatever. Tesla's belongings were seized and sealed under them, thereby bringing the Trump's into the story.







John G. Trump had already been a professor at MIT when the Alien Property Custodian's called him on the telephone. He was also an electrical engineer, developing radar systems with the National Defense Research Committee of the Office of Scientific Research and Development. That was long winded, wasn't it? After the War, he returned to MIT and was appointed director of the High Voltage Research Laboratory so as to pursue industrial applications of electrostatic energy. After a three-day investigation, Trump reported that none of Tesla's confiscated materials had "significant value to this country" nor would they "constitute a hazard in unfriendly hands." His conclusion painted Tesla's late-career projects as speculative, philosophical, and primarily promotional, and that his wireless transmissions "did not include new sound workable principles or methods." Did I manage all those different

quotes right? Mm-hmm, Nikola Tesla was the most brilliant scientist alive, and Trump found nothing useful in him. *Bummer*. To quote Porky Pig, "*Th-th-th-that's all folks*." Get out of here. Go home. No, really. There's nothing more to this story, resembling nothing of a smoke screen.



Well, anyways, Nikola Tesla had a thing for the birds, particularly a white **pigeon** that visited him daily. That was the same year as the first **Back To the Future** movie and *also* the passing of John G. Trump, who died on 2/21/85. You will tell me that I am simply attempting to assign a pecking order by killing two birds with one stone, and that a bird in the hand is worth two in the bush. Don't be such a featherweight. Spreading my

wings isn't the same thing as flying the coop. I night owl notices these things, and have you heard the one about the early bird catching the first worm?





Roll your eyes all you want but you won't be laughing after I show you Trump's next Tesla connection. There he is at Mar-a-Lago, writing his inaugural address, ruling the roost. The time stamp is 1/18/2017. Check out the tile behind him, why don't you? Talk about a nest egg. Wedged between two pillars are the words PLUS ULTRA. Sounds like a clue to one thing or another. I *checked*. 'Plus ultra' is a Latin phrase which means "further beyond," and is the national motto of Spain. According to official history, Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor and King of Spain, adopted the motto following the discovery of the New World by Columbus, *I know*. It is a 180 reversal of the original Latin phrase NON-PLUS ULTRA, which meant, "Nothing further beyond," and was said to have been inscribed as a warning on the Pillars of Hercules at the Strait of Gibraltar, marking the edge of the known world. Not seeing any connections there? Yeah, me neither. Well, at least we learned something. Let's keep looking.





In 2015, the very year that Marty arrived to the future, Disney released a movie called 'Tomorrowland'. Its backstory revolves around a secret society called, wait for it, Plus Ultra. Well, that didn't take long. It was founded in 1889 at the Exposition Universelle in Paris of all places, by Nikola Tesla of all people, as well as Thomas Edison, Jules Verne, and

Gustave Eiffel, all of whom were futurists. Well, thank God they met inside Eiffel's Tower rather than his other contribution to the world, the tranny and Luciferian modeled Statue of Liberty. And of course, Jules Verne was off the charts Freemason and Rosicrucian, breaking every gay detector known to man. The Disney movie also includes Walt Disney as a later member, how cute. The Sonora Aero Club and Trump

[UPDATE 4/16/25: THE very first person to ride the Trump Train was a man named Charles Dellschau, and he left behind the artwork to prove it to us. Have you ever seen a train decked in so much gold? Choochoo. All aboard to Mar-a-Lago. What's going on within the little circular window? I'm talking about the one directly underneath the letters 'T' and 'R'. Tell me the boy doesn't resemble Barron Trump, and while you're at it, that the man oiling the TRUMP train doesn't look like the Big D.

Dellschau's earliest known work is a diary dated to 1899, the last is an 80page book dated 1921-1922, giving his career as an artist a 21-year span. And yet, up until The Sixties he was a complete unknown. We are told of a Houston house fire and 12 notebooks of artwork which were placed on the sidewalk to be discarded. Fred Washington, a local antiques and used furniture dealer, spotted the books, and for \$100 bought them from the trash collector. Afterwards, in 1968, Mary Jane Victor, an art student at the University of St. Thomas in Houston stumbled upon the notebooks. Since that time, Dellschau's work has been parceled out to museums and private collectors all across the world, with a double-sided page dated to 1919 finally selling for \$22,500 at Christie's in 2016. Might I remind you that the CIA runs the art world, hence The CIA In ART. They sponsor their boys down at the canvas and paint warehouse by hiking up the price tags at auctions. One could very well say that the Dellschau narrative was created by the Deep State but then if we're being honest very few people know about the man, and a Hallmark sign of the PSYOP Department is dramatizing their investments. With Dellschau, they are not.



Charles Dellschau may be a time traveler, given the scenario before us, but the more likely scenario is that he was an acquaintance of time travelers, though again, even his diaries may have been planted, further indicating that even Dellschau's story was fabricated. As I was saying, little is known about Dellschau's life. I can only find one reported picture of him, and he isn't wearing a MAGA hat. We are told on his Wiki page that primary sources are scarce, and that secondary sources often contain contradictory information. You'll see what I mean in a moment. What is known is that he was born in 1830, that he emigrated from Prussia to Texas in 1850, where he worked as a butcher, and that he died in 1923, but how certain can we be? Soon after arriving in Texas he was married to Antonia Hilt, a widow of Pierre Hilt, who already had a daughter from a previous marriage. Together they had three children, two

daughters, Bertha and Mary, and a son, Edward, though Edward died as a child, the same year as Antonia.

In 1865, Dellschau signed the Civil War Amnesty Oath, indicating that he was a soldier for the Confederacy. This document is an important one, because in it, Dellschau is described as having a fair complexion, 5'3" with auburn hair and hazel eyes. Afterwards, Dellschau lived in Houston until his death. We are furthermore told that his house remained in his family after his death, and that his notebooks remained untouched for decades. That is, until the house fire and garbage truck story. Yup, his very identity may have been an invented one.

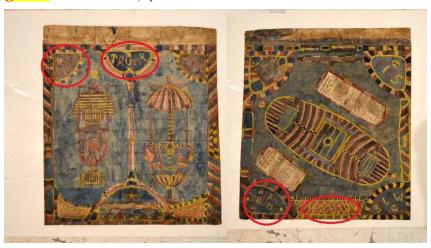




The most intriguing part of Dellschau's story has nothing to do with his official records and everything to do with the fictional bio accounted for us in his diaries, see what I did there? His artwork claims to be a record of the activities of the **Sonora Aero Club**, of which he was a purported member. His writings describe a **secret group** of **flight enthusiasts** who met in a saloon in **Sonora**, California in the **1800's**, and though Dellschau never claimed to be a pilot or an airship designer, he himself was chosen as their draftsman. This would necessitate that his twentieth century artwork, if it is indeed twentieth century, were later renditions of what he had either seen or drawn in an earlier decade.

It should be noted that researchers have found no evidence of the Sonora Aero Club's existence outside of Dellschau's work, making his two decades obsession all the more enticing. No surprise, its members, including Peter Mennis, Tosh Wilson, Louis Caro, and Jacob Mischer, are not substantiated by historical records. Census records, voting rosters, and death records have all come up empty, though I am told a few gravestones in the Columbia Cemetery share identical surnames. Peter Mennis in particular is described as a genius and inventor

of the "Lifting Fluid" called "Supe," with the club's mission being to design and build the first navigable aircraft using an NB Gas for lift and propulsion, though who was financing it and where were the tests done? The flying machines would be called Aeros. Have you ever stopped to appreciate the fact that they were eventually called airplanes and not airglobes? It's the little joys in life.



Anywho, there Dellschau was, sitting around in the Sierra's with his Sonora Aero Club peeps, drinking whiskey rather than water from the trough. The year was 1858 when he drafted up these beauties of futurism and science. They are designs for anti-gravity devices. TRUMP is scribbled all over his class notes. In fact, the flying ship on the right is quite literally called an AERO TRUMP. On closer inspection it is a man named Homer Trump, who is he? Hopefully, it is not another 'Simpsons' prediction. Perhaps there is a connection with Homer, Alaska?







There's a very loose Frederick Trump connection in all of this. It is a connection non-the-less, and still worth mentioning for other reasons. FYI, Frederick just so happens to be the patriarch of the Trump family

and the paternal grandfather of Donald Trump. I am showing you three separate photos of Frederick through the years. Left to right, Trump is a teenager in 1887, soon after immigrating to America. Next, he is poised next to his wife Elizabeth Christ in 1902. And then, with his three children, which include Fred, Louise, and John. This is the story of Frederick Trump according to Wiki, and it's super shady. Follow along if you'd like, as I'll be summarizing.

He was born and raised in Kallstadt, Germany in 1869 in what was then the Kingdom of Bavaria. After being sick with emphysema for 10 years, Trump's father, Christian Johannes, died in 1877, leaving the family in severe debt from medical expenses. Though five of his siblings worked in the grape fields, Frederick was considered too sickly for the task, and so, in 1883, at the age of 14, he was sent to Frankenthal by his mother to work as a barber's apprentice. After laboring seven days a week for two consecutive years and some change under barber Friedrich Lang, Trump completed his apprenticeship and returned home. There was, however, a new development in the saga of his life. He had reached the age of eligibility for conscription to military service in the Imperial German Army, prompting him to become a draft dodger and make the big move to America. He later claimed, "I agreed with my mother that I should go to America," though his family members stated that he departed secretly at night, leaving his mother a note. As a result, a royal decree was later issued banishing Trump from the country.

He arrived in NYC aboard the steamship Eider on 10/19/1885 and has the paperwork to prove it. But then, as early as 1891, he began speculating in real estate in Seattle. All we are told is that he was capable of purchasing the Poodle Dog on 208 Washington Street, which he renamed the Dairy Restaurant, with his life savings of several hundred dollars. How many heads would one have to trim in the 1890's and mustaches wax to even account for that? Was he filling the tip jar sidelining a barbershop quartet as well? Well anyways, Richy Rich chose a business venture which was smackdab in the middle of Seattle's Pioneer Square. Washington Street was nicknamed "the Line" for its assortment of saloons, casinos, and brothels. Trump's restaurant served food and liquor and was advertised to include "Rooms for Ladies", a common euphemism for prostitution.

Rumors regarding financial investments by John D. Rockefeller in the Everett area, not far from Seattle, prompted Trump to buy a plot of land in Monte Christo for \$200, where he built a boarding house near to the

train station to "mine the miners," as they say. He conveniently pulled out of that investment before the Rockefeller's did, sparing his fortune when others were destituted. He then turned to the **Klondike Gold Rush**, where he made a buttload of money operating a restaurant and a brothel for miners in Whitehorse. Is this where we find a Homer connection? Probably not, as most Klondike gold rushers landed in Dyea or Skagway. Conveniently again, right about when the Government announced the suppression of prostitution, gambling and liquor via the Mounties crackdown, Trump sold off his share to his partner and left the Yukon, once again managing to emerge on top, whereas most did not. Within a few short years, the restaurant burned down in the Whitehorse fire of 1905, ruining the rest of them. Oh, and did I mention, he may have been a Frederick, but he was born Friedrich, thereby emphasizing the rich in Friedrich.

In 1901, Trump returned to Kallstadt long enough to marry Elisabeth Christ, the daughter of Philipp Christ, a descendant of Johann Michael Hartung the organ builder. He didn't stay there, though. In retaliation to his being a draft dodger, the Bavarian Government stripped him of his citizenship in 1905, prompting him to move back to the United States. Trump then worked opened up a barber shop in Manhattan and managed a hotel while he began to acquire real estate in Queens. Elisabeth Trump helped to certify the family fortune with Fred, Donald Trump's father, after he died in the 1918 flu pandemic.

Aside from the apparent fact that a poor runaway German immigrant was capable of amassing a huge fortune in the west, and with uncanny insight, as investments go, there is a lingering question. Did Frederick Trump or any Trump for that matter end up in Dellschau's artwork? No, we do not have a record of him in Sonora, nor was he alive in the 1850's, and so the saying 'close but no cigar' would normally be well suited to this one, except that we are dealing with time travel, where foresight is just as applicable as hindsight. And another thing, did Trump the real estate tycoon and hotel manager happen to have a run-in with Nikola Tesla?]





Baron and Barron Trump

[UPDATE 3/16/23: AND so, with time travel potentially already being a thing of the past, it really shouldn't surprise anyone to find traces of residue. Sudden emergences in the pages of His-Story might be a better way to describe it. Like Marty McFly's tampering with George McFly the science fiction novelist in his teenage bedroom, we too may discover the creepy crawly of time bandits, by which I give you Ingersoll Lockwood's book series. Ever heard of him? Yeah, me neither. Nobody had until 2017 by the sounds of it.

The **Baron Trump novels** are two children's novels written in 1889 and 1893 by American author and lawyer Ingersoll Lockwood. They remained obscure until 2017, when they received media attention for perceived similarities between their protagonist and U.S. President Donald Trump.

There is even a <u>Wiki article</u> discussing the strange emergence after a century and some change of total obscurity from the limelight. What they don't tell you is that the conspiracy theorists were on it first before the Media ever picked up the story. But a just as likely scenario is that spooks exhumed Lockwood's novels from obscurity and worked the room in a 4chan thread, offering conspiracy theorists first dibs before handing the leftovers over to the normies, via the News, the usual order of events.

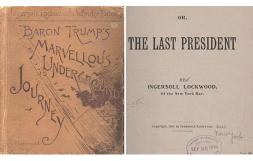
Well, here is some information about the books. This Lockwood fellow was a lawyer and for a time America's Consul to the Kingdom of Hanover, appointed by **Abraham Lincoln**. He eventually got around to publishing two children's books. His first, "The Travels and Adventures of Little **Baron Trump** and His Wonderful Dog Bulger', was released in **1890**. 'Baron Trump's Marvelous Underground Journey' was its **1893** follow-up. There was yet another book published three years later, in

1896. That one was provocatively titled '1900: or The Last President'. We shall have to take a closer look at that one, for sure.

The Baron Trump novels recount the adventures of the German boy Wilhelm Heinrich Sebastian Von Troomp, who simply goes by 'Baron Trump'. Supposing you're already lost to the parallels being proposed, **Barron Trump** is Donald Trump's only child with First Lady **Melania**. Mind you, that is only where similarities between Trump's son and the fictional Trump begin. There are others. Little Baron Trump is described as deriving from a wealthy family that lives on 5th Avenue in New York City, in what is furthermore referred to as Trump Castle. If you need this spelled out for you, Barron Trump was raised in Trump Tower on 5th Ave., NYC.

The plot follows Little Baron and his dog Bulger on a series of Wonderland-like nonsense adventures through other dimensions and time with the help of a mystical character named **Don Fum**. Don helps Baron and Bulger find the portal to his 'World within a World' that eventually leads them to... *wait for it*... **Russia**. You've got to be kidding me. As if portals and parallel dimensions were even a thing back then. Seriously, what child was on the schoolyard discussing string theory and the multiverse in 1890? 'The Adventures of Little Baron Trump' may have lifted its inspiration from 'Alice's Adventures In Wonderland', but the intended pretense of nonsense literature, which was undoubtedly popular at the time, is probably just that—a convenient guise.

Follow the Wiki link that I earlier showed you and it describes Trump's adventures as one wherein he discovers "weird underground civilizations, offends the natives, flees from his entanglements with local women, and repeats this pattern until arriving back home at Castle Trump." Sounds like the Trump administration we've come to know.







Even the physical similarities between Baron and Barron cannot be ignored. If one is an incident and two a coincidence, and three's starting to resemble a pattern. Well, onto your fourth or your fifth then.

Trump has never been fond of pets, and in fact, the Media made a point of hammering that little tidbit out soon after his election in 2016, probably in hopes of dehumanizing him. Had he entered the White House without one, he would have been the first president to do so in 150 years. He did arrive with a dog though. The details given to us by the same Media reports [such as this article in The Sun, tough it appears to have originated with The Washington Post] make the Baron-Bulger connection all that much more of a potent one. While attending a Thanksgiving event at the Trump's Mar-a-Lago home, philanthropist Lois Pope showed Donald a picture of the 9-week-old Goldendoodle she was raising. Apparently, Trump instructed her to show Barron the pooch picture, by which he cried immediately. There is your *first* Baron-Bulger connection.

Barron Trump's dog goes by the name of **Patton**. As in four-star General **George S. Patton**. Why would Baron's fictional dog from the novel be named Bulger then? It is carefully coded. Patton was an instrumental factor in the Allies victory at the **Battle of the Bulge**. There is your Bulger connection.







As mentioned earlier, Lockwood's final novel was '1900: Or the Last President', and you'll never guess what the plot involves. It begins in November—election season. New York City is in chaos while anarchists protest a corrupt election process wherein a YUGE-ly unpopular outsider candidate wins his ticket into the White House. And then look at what we read.

"...mobs of vast size are organizing under the lead of anarchists and socialists, and threaten to plunder and despoil the houses of the rich who have wronged and oppressed them for so many years..."

Though Baron Trump is no longer present this time around, Lockwood once again begins his narrative at a Fifth Avenue hotel, precisely where Trump Tower now stands. The paperback is only 52 pages. It's very difficult not seeing a 9/11 style predictive programming in all of this. You will tell me Donald Trump wasn't the last president. Joe Biden arrived with dementia after him, making Lockwood's book a failed prediction. Is that so? 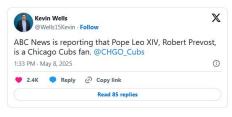


Immediately after Pope Francis' passing, Trump posted a rather provocative message on Truth Social. "Rest in Peace Pope Francis! May

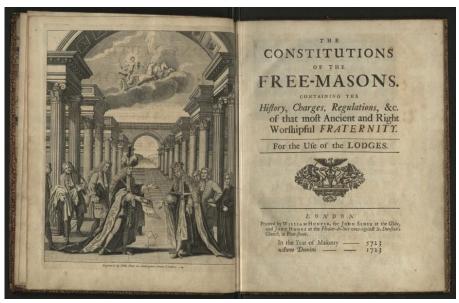

The War of the Wizards came to my attention years ago during a Marina Abramovic interview, held on stage of all places. Like Aleister Crowley and others of her elk, Marina Abramovic is evil-incarnate. This is what she said:

In Lapland there is a group of them in the shamans there who do something called collective dreaming. They will go together in seclusion and do rituals with, you know, eating very little food and being in solitude for a long time, and they will go and dream the dreams. And the dream have to be called 'the same dream.' So, coming out of this dream this one shaman told me that actually, the best thing happened is in this planet right now is the Trump to be the president. I said, 'How is this possibly the best thing to happen?' He said, 'Yes, because-because he's so irrational. He's so crazy that it's actually create that awakening, that we finally wake up, because before we have another guy and another guy, and everything is similar. But he's so different than anything else. So actually, he's the Magician who is waking us up.

Abramovic's visit with the Finnish shamans happened presumedly while supposed Reality and the Mandela Effect were holding hands as part of a tightwire act in 2016. One of them explained to her the purpose of the Trump presidency. They had gotten together in ritualistic seclusion, eating very little, dreaming dreams. And then it happened. They dreamed the

same dream—in a decade inhabited by collective false memories. Trump was brought onto the scene to create the awakening.

And then she said it. Marina Abramovic actually went there. She called Donald Trump a Magician. A magician in case you were unaware is someone who manipulates the natural world through alchemical means so as to lead people towards enlightenment or contrarily into the darkness. Also, despite her quote-unquote "surprise" in all of this, Abramovic is somewhat of a Magician herself. But just as importantly, she's a performance artist for the Elite. You'd think someone like that would know the script even when she's acting the part of improv, but maybe I'm giving her more credit than she deserves.



Abramovic is directing our attention to tarot, of which the Magician card is numbered One on the list. That's the Fool card, being identified with the Trickster. You can read all about that in The Trickster and Lucille Ball. It's not a coincidence that 'The Economist' made the very comparison in December 2016, after her interview. The Magician is associated with Mercury—alchemy. He is seen standing with one arm stretched upwards towards the Universe, the other pointing down towards earth, connecting the spiritual realm with the material. As above, so below, which is the occults way of describing 'On Earth as it is in Heaven.' It is therefore the Magician who uses this symbiotic relationship as an intercessor to create and manifest his goals in the physical realm. He is the conduit by which energy is converted into matter. Typically, 'order out of chaos' is their manner of accomplishing it.

The typical Magician tarot depicts four items on the table before him—a cup, pentacle, sword, and wand. They are the four elements. Water, earth,

air, and fire. The Economist substitutes these symbols for four houses, which the Magician is creating from a 3D printer, and the virtual reality goggles remind us that everything is an illusion. The typical Magician card depicts a belt which doubles as an ouroboros, a snake eating its own tail. You see, time is in the cards after all. The Economist, however, keeps to the infinity symbol above his head. It reminds us of the number 8. As in the 88 miles per hour required for the flux capacitor to do its work.
